

One of the aims of the Architecture and Healthcare series of panel discussions is to raise awareness of the themes addressed by the new Level II Master Degree Programme in Architecture and Health held at the University luav of Venice in collaboration with - and with the support of - Ulss3 Serenissima, VSFP Veneta Healthcare Project Finance, Villa Salus Foundation and numerous specialised private companies. The involvement in the debate of participants from diverse professions highlights the importance of a post-graduate training path that takes a holistic and interdisciplinary approach, providing the essential training needed to improve the quality of the system and, consequently, of the physical structures that host healthcare facilities.

The initiative is aimed at healthcare users in the Veneto Region and will involve presentations given by managers of the regional offices of the AULSS (local healthcare units) who are already taking on this systemic role while being aware of how the theme of Architecture and Healthcare is being addressed in other countries. The purpose of this series of panel discussions is to stimulate debate in ten topics relating to the design of healthcare facilities. These include the humanisation of hospitals, the benefits of the built environment in the care process, and the safety and sustainability of hospital facilities. The discussion between architects, engineers, doctors, managers and healthcare operators will be followed by Q and A sessions with the audience.
